Art. 1 The competition is open to musicians of all nationalities and musical training. The competition will take place at the auditorium of the Church of San Giuseppe in via Pisa 37 in Marina di Massa from 21 to 25 April 2023

Art. 2 The enrollment form (Signed and completed) and the receipt of the registration fee (refundable only in case of cancellation of the competition), will have to be received by April 5 2023 via the email: associazioneclaraschumann@gmail.com

The subject line in the registration mail must outline the name of the candidate as well as the music section and category.

Art. 3 Requests to participate in the competition must be sent by email to associazioneclaraschumann@gmail.com no later than April 5, 2023 and it must include the following documentation in digital format:

- Application form
- Copy of the payment of the registration fee
- Copy of a valid identity document

Art. 4 Performances must present only published original music. Performance by memory is not mandatory.

Art. 5 Candidates may enroll in a category higher but not lower than their age. In the case of the chamber music section, age is calculated based on the group's average age.

Art. 6 The results of each category will be communicated at the end of auditions and published on the website <https://fini-giorgini.it/concorso/> and on the competition Facebook.

Art. 7 The jury is composed of highly qualified musical personalities:

Piano section:

M° Daniel Rivera Pianist, President and Professor at Conservatorio "P. Mascagni" in Livorno.

M° Francesca Costa: Pianist, Professor at Conservatorio "G. Puccini" in La Spezia.

M° Sabrina Dente: Pianist, Professor at Conservatorio "G. Donizetti" in Bergamo.

Chamber music section:

M° Paolo Ardinghi: Violinist, President, Professor at Conservatorio "Luigi Boccherini" in Lucca

M° Francesca Costa: Pianist, Professor at Conservatorio "G. Puccini" in La Spezia.

M° Alessio Bacci: Flautist, Professor at Conservatorio "G. Puccini" in La Spezia

Art. 8 Candidates cannot have any kind of educational relationship with the members of the jury.

Art. 9 The final scores will be expressed in centesimal order. The judgement of the jury is unquestionable.

Art. 10 The artistic direction has the right to cancel the competition for proven reasons. In this case, the registration fee will be returned.

Art. 11 The artistic direction takes all responsibility over the competition.

Art. 12 . In case of dispute, the only legitimate text will be the one published on the web site <https://fini-giorgini.it/concorso/>. For any dispute, the Massa court will be considered the competent venue.

Art. 13 Award concerts do not provide for reimbursements of food, accommodation expenses and artistic fee.

First section: Piano

Cat. First notes: Born from 2016 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 4 minutes.

Cat. A Born from 2013 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 5 minutes.

Cat. B Born from 2011 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 7 minutes.

Cat. C Born from 2009 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 10 minutes.

Cat. D Born from 2007 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 15 minutes.

Cat. E Born from 2005 onwards.
Maximum duration of performance 20 minutes.

Cat. F "Piano Award" Without age limits.

- Elimantory round: one " Study" and first movement of a "Sonata".
- Final round: free repertory. Maximum duration of performance 30 minutes.
(The sonata of the elimantory round can be performed in full)

Second section: Chamber music (All the group from duo onwards, including piano 4 hands).

Cat. A Average age 14 years.

Maximum duration of performance 10 minutes.

Cat. B Average age 20 years.

Maximum duration of performance 20 minutes.

Cat. C Without age limits.

Maximum duration of performance 25 minutes.

To the fourth with a score from 80 to 84/100: certificate and medal.

All participants who will report a score less than 80/100: certificate of participation.

The award concerts will be held for the following concert season:

Audience Award: 200 €. All absolute winners of the category of the piano chamber music section, will perform on April 25, 2023 during the final award concert. The jury will be composed of supporters of the Crowdfunding project “Help Clara Schumann build scholarships for the winners of the competition” belonging to the rewards: Donator “Allegro”, Donator “Presto”, Donator “Presto con fuoco” and Donator “Ad libitum”.

At the end of the concert and award ceremony, the audience jury will decide on a single winner among all performers.

The absence at the award ceremony implies the renunciation of the category and audience prize.
